Car Rider Information

Dear GRDMS Families,

A new GRDMS car rider procedure will be implemented as of February 22, 2021. For the safety of all students, please follow the car rider procedures listed below.

Car Rider Tags

Car rider tag numbers will be assigned to the oldest child of each family. All families will receive two identical car tags. Families with multiple children will be assigned the same car tag number per family. One car tag is required to be hung/visible when you pick up your child. The second car tag provided should be used as a replacement when needed.

PLEASE NOTE: Parents/guardians are required to complete the [GRDMS Car Rider Online Application](#) prior to receipt of a GRDMS car rider tag.

Morning Arrival:

The car rider line will open daily at 8:15 - 8:45 AM to allow students to enter the building. **PLEASE DO NOT DROP OFF YOUR STUDENT BEFORE 8:15 AM as there is no adult supervision prior to this time.** Students are encouraged to arrive and be in classrooms by 8:45 AM to begin the instructional day. Students who arrive after 8:45AM are considered tardy and will be provided with a tardy slip. *Excessive tardiness will be documented and may result in administrative and/or counselor intervention.* Student will be monitored to allow for responsible distancing.

Afternoon Dismissal:

Dismissal of car riders will begin at 3:55 PM - 4:15 PM. One car tag number is required to be hung/visible when you pick up your child. **Please remain in your vehicle, follow the flow of traffic, and your child will be safely directed to enter the vehicle at the designated school curbside location.** No child will be permitted to walk across the parking lot or through traffic. To ensure appropriate responsible distancing, adults will no longer be permitted to park, stand to wait for, or walk up and retrieve students. If you arrive after 4:15 PM, adults will be required to present proper I.D. in order to be allowed to pick up a child. *Excessive late pick-ups will be documented and may result in administrative intervention.* Students will be monitored to allow for responsible distancing.

Safety Reminders:

- **PLEASE DO NOT DROP OFF STUDENTS BEFORE 8:15 AM as there is no adult supervision prior to this time.**
- **Car rider tags are required for dismissal.** *If you do not have your car rider tag when you arrive, adults will be required to present proper identification in order to be allowed to pick up a child. This ensures that students are safely released only to those whom the parent/guardian has authorized for pick up.*
- **No student check outs are allowed after 3:30 PM.**
- **To ensure responsible distancing, adults will not be allowed to park and/or walk up to the building for pick up; please remain in your vehicle & follow the traffic pattern.**

PLEASE HELP US TO MAINTAIN THE SAFETY OF ALL OF OUR STUDENTS!
