Dear Parents,

Beginning on May 3rd, students in Grades 6-8 will join other elementary and middle school students district wide in taking the Georgia Milestones End-of-Grade Assessment. Although student performance is measured year-round by teachers, this test is a standardized measure for students to demonstrate their mastery of core academic subjects through established criteria set by the Georgia Department of Education.

Information provided by these assessments include:

- establishing individual student achievement levels.
- assessing strengths and weaknesses of individuals and programs.
- determining student academic growth.
- guiding us as we plan for overall school improvement.

Eighth graders will be tested in four content areas: English/language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies. Sixth and seventh graders will be tested in English/language arts and mathematics. Each content area assessment has two or three sections ranging from 20-90 minutes depending on the content and section. Testing will begin each day by **9:00** a.m. Hybrid students will follow the testing schedule outlined below.

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Georgia Milestones Assessments are required by the State of Georgia; however, we know these are unprecedented times due to the COVID-19 pandemic. All students, virtual and hybrid, are offered the opportunity to participate in Georgia Milestones testing.

Health and safety remain a top priority in Rockdale County Public Schools. RCPS takes seriously the safety and well-being of our students, families, and staff. We will implement a number of rules and safeguards in order to safely administer End-of-Grade and End-of-Course testing during the 2020-21 school year. While we encourage all students to participate, we will not require virtual students to come into the school for the purpose of testing. Eighth grade Coordinate Algebra students who do not participate in the End-of-Course Assessment will be issued a zero, which will be calculated at 0.01% for their course grade. EOC students will not be issued an Incomplete nor will they be expected to take the assessment at a later date. **Please go to your school's portal page and complete the Milestones Survey regarding your child's participation.**

PRE-REGISTRATION:

- If your child will attend school through the Hybrid model, you do not need to pre-register.

We ask that you assist us in preparing your child for testing by adhering to the following guidelines:

- **Maintain your child's normal schedule, including adequate rest, nourishing meals, and time for relaxation and play.**
- **Discuss with your child the importance of doing his/her best.**
- **Refrain from taking your child out of school during the testing sessions.**
- **Be sure your child arrives at school on time during testing days.**
- **Express confidence in your child's ability to do well.**
