6th Grade FAQ's:

How do I find my class schedule? Will I receive a paper copy? Log in to ClassLink > itsLearning > Class Schedules. Paper copies available on a limited basis.

Do I have to know my student number? Breakfast and lunch are provided free of charge to all students through the end of this year.

Can I bring my lunch? Yes; outside restaurant containers are not permitted.

How can I check my grades? Log in to ClassLink > Infinite Campus > Grades

Do we receive paper report cards? Grade reports are available online on the Parent Portal and formally published at 4.5 week/9 week/end of semester intervals.

What if I forget my Username? Password? Username = 9+first initial+last name + @students.rockdale.k12.ga.us
Password = 9+first initial + last initial + last 5 digits of RCPS student #

What should I do if I have problems logging in to class? Restart > Log in to ClassLink > itsLearning

What if my student laptop is not working? Parents/guardians should visit the GRDMS website to schedule an appointment with Intel for tech assistance.

Do I have to wear my mask all day? Yes, to promote safety for yourself and others. You may remove your mask while eating/drinking.

Do we have lockers? Lockers are not available. You will be responsible for carrying your belongings throughout the school day. Only bring what is necessary for learning.

Do we have recess in middle school? There are times to participate in Wellness activities.

Transportation

Arrival 8:15-8:45am

School doors open at 8:15am; there is no supervision prior to this time.

Students are **tardy** after 8:45am

Car-riders – enter front/main entrance

Bus-riders – enter from bus lane through designated gr. level door

Dismissal - Begins at 3:55pm

Car-riders – exit to the front entrance when your assigned car-rider # is displayed on the classroom projector. Car-rider car tags are **required**.

Bus-riders – exit to the bus lane when your bus # is displayed on the classroom projector.

Transportation Changes &

Early Check Outs - Appropriate ID is **required** for check out. Early check-outs are not allowed after 3:30pm.
